APPLICATION GUIDE

- Coverage is approximately 20m2 per litre. Only one good coat is required.
- When applying to objects via spray, hold 30cm away from object. Start from the top and coat evenly from one side to the other.
- Reapplication in exterior applications is recommended after every 6-8 months.
